2.1 Fix for Schedule Analysis Viewer Authentication

Location in System: Import/Export → Network Analysis System (SDEF) Analyze Schedule

Problem Statement: In the last release, RMS now can view native Primavera XER files. Some users were being denied access to the Analyze Schedule screen due to Permissions not being honored. This has been fixed.
